

THE NEW ZEALAND SUSTAINABILITY FUND

Utilise has formed, and manages, a fund to assist New Zealand businesses reduce their emissions under Scope 2 (electricity) and Scope 1 (direct transport emissions). NZSF focuses on utilising available roof space to provide on-site energy without requiring expensive grid upgrades.

We believe that utilising existing capacity is the first step on the decarbonisation journey for businesses.

We manage our funding in tranches of approximately \$10m. If a project does not make it into the current round of funding it will be moved to top of the list for the next tranche of funding. We encourage companies with viable projects to confirm intentions so they may be placed into the current round of funding.

Every business is different but there are ways every business can make even small changes. To take this first step NZSF will undertake an emissions reduction assessment. The assessment report will include system sizing, generation, on-site consumption, emission reductions, financial costs and benefits of real world emission reduction actions available, and recommended to you.

National emissions profile

Of the four main sources of emissions in New Zealand (Agriculture, Energy, Industrial Processes and Product Use and Waste), the NZSF focuses on reducing emissions in the energy space. Specifically, electricity generation and transport. This chart highlights these areas (shown in green).
